1. Contractor shall be responsible for notifying all underground utilities, or statewide "Call Before You Dig" number 1-800-922-4455 prior to excavation.
2. Contractor shall be responsible for notifying the MIFD Roads Manager (Rufus Allyn, 860-235-3465) 24 hours prior to the start of work and work must be backfilled at the end of day so as to insure two lane traffic, unless roadway is only one lane.
3. In performing all work, the road will have one lane open to insure adequate flow of traffic at all times. All ditches shall be backfilled at the end of day so as to insure two lane traffic, unless roadway is only one lane.
4. All work must be performed in accordance with ordinance entitled: "Ordinance re Permits to Work or Excavate in or Under MIFD-managed Roads."
5. This permit will remain in effect for one (1) year from the date of issue, or until revoked by the MIFD Roads Manager, whichever occurs first. Contractor will be responsible for any maintenance during that time.
